The following funds are currently established and accepting charitable donations.

Greer Fund – provides scholarships for employee’s / their children’s education. (Also known as Employee Education Fund.)

Smith Fund – Provides modest *midyear* bonuses to staff.

Healthcare Education Fund – underwrites group classes for healthcare staff to keep pace with new best practices, technologies or equipment.

Employee Recognition Fund – underwrites two staff parties each year wherein employees are recognized for service milestones and special efforts.

Employee Relief Fund – provides assistance to ARC employees in disastrous/crisis situations.

Resident Gift Fund – provides staff bonuses at year-end. (Also known as the Tip Fund, gifts to this fund are not currently tax deductible.)

Resident Assistance Fund – provides assistance to ARC residents who have outlived their financial resources. (Also known as the Widow’s Fund or ARC Charitable Endowment)

Other gift designations are encouraged after a simple conversation with the Chief Executive Officer, Director of Development or Chief Financial Officer.

Gifts made in memory or honor of our residents, associates, or others may be made payable to the ARC Foundation with the fund name in the memo line of checks. An acknowledgment of the gift will be provided to both the donor and the honoree or their family members.
